Flower Granny Square Pattern

Use yarn in 3 different shades.

Crochet Abbreviations

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

tr = treble crochet



To start, chain 5 and join with a slip stitch.

R1: Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), 11 dc in ring (12 double crochet stitches). Fasten off first color.

R2: With second color, make a standing treble crochet in any dc from the previous row. Work 3 more tr in same stitch.

Remove hook from loop and insert hook into the top of starting tr

Then use hook to pull loop through the top of the first stitch. Petal made. Ch 2.

*4 tr in next stitch, remove hook from loop, insert into the top of the 1st tr of the petal and pull the last loop through. Ch 2 Repeat from * 10 more times. (12 petals). Join with a slip st to 1st st in round. Fasten off second color.

In the next row, work groups of stitches into each of the ch-2 spaces from row 2. Also note that the puffy petals are on the right side of your work.

R3: Join third color with a slip stitch in any ch 2 space. Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc). In same space, work 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc (1st corner made).

Work 3 dc in each of the next 2 spaces. *In next space, work 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc (corner made), work 3 dc in each of the next 2 spaces. Repeat from * 2 more times. Join with a sl st to top of 1st ch 3.

You can stop your Daisy Granny Square here, or continue to work one or more rows of a traditional granny square pattern as follows:

R4: Sl st in next 2 st and in corner space. In same corner space, ch 3 and work 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc (corner made). 3 dc in each of the next 3 spaces, * (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner space, 3 dc in each of the next 3 spaces. Repeat from * 2 more times. Join with sl st to top of 1st ch 3. Fasten off yarn and weave in the yarn tails.
